10 Tips for A Great 1st Day By Shawn Davis



As the summer draws to a close, the back-toschool season begins. It is not uncommon for parents and students to be excited, albeit with some anxiety. As we head back to school, there will certainly be excitement and jitters on the first day. Getting back into the school year routine is always a challenge after enjoying the lazy days of summer. Thus, here are some tips to help you and your child prepare for a successful return to school.

I. Set Expectations; explain to your children that this school year's experience will look different than the year prior. Going into the next grade level comes with unique challenges and brand-new experiences. They may have questions so please set aside time to answer their questions using age-appropriate language and gently let them know that you will be there to help them through the transition.

2. Please take care of any and all doctor and dentist visits.

3. Create a Morning Routine: Please practice the following with your child:

- Create an Evening To-Do-List
- Prepare Lunch
- Pack Your Child's Backpack
- Lay Out Clothes for Next Day
- Set Alarm and Be Consistent

4. Create a Back-to-School Lunch Menu. Students can be very particular about what they choose to eat. To avoid morning and lunch confrontations, ask for your child's assistance in choosing what they would like to eat for the week.

5. Implement an Earlier Bedtime. Students who have an early bedtime function better during the day. When students are tired, they become cranky and difficult to handle. Studies show that children who have an earlier bedtime, have better short and long-term memory, a better attention span, and are able to regulate their emotions better.

6. Send an email to your child's teacher introducing yourself and your child. Let the teacher know of any medications, allergies or important information they may need to know about your child.

7. Limit the amount of technology your child is using in preparation for the new school year.

8. Touch base with classroom friends. Students will feel more confident going to school when they know familiar faces that will be in their classroom.

9. Make arrangements for Before and After Care if needed.

10. Talk about school and Focus on the Positives.
