



## School Tuition Organizations

### Please Apply for All Applicable Scholarship Categories

- 1) Disabled/Displaced – **This is the highest funding source for students with Autism.** Under Lexie’s Law, awards are available for students with an Arizona State approved disability(ies). **These scholarships are available to students K- 12<sup>th</sup> grade who have an AZ public/charter school IEP or MET.** There is no prior year AZ public or charter school enrollment requirement. **If using this option for funding, Autism Academy only accepts funding based on the primary eligibility of Autism.**
- 2) Switcher/Plus – Switching from an AZ public/charter school to an AZ private school. There is a prior year AZ public/charter school enrollment of at least 90 days as a requirement for students who are applying for grades 1<sup>st</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>. Enrollment requirement can be waived if your child has never attended an AZ public or charter school.
- 3) Corporate/Low Income – Family income based. There is a prior year AZ public/charter school enrollment of at least 90 days as a requirement for students who are applying for grades 1<sup>st</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>. Enrollment requirement can be waived if your child has never attended an AZ public or charter school. The requirements to receive aid under the low-income program are based on 185% of the Free & Reduced lunch program guidelines. See the chart below for an **example** of qualification levels:

- 4) Original/Individual – Individuals and couples receive a dollar-for-dollar credit for their Arizona tax liability. This is an Arizona State tax credit. Funding availability for the Original/Individual scholarship is based on the tax credits received by the STOs. There is no prior year enrollment requirement. K-12 students attending a qualified private school in Arizona are eligible to receive the Original/Individual scholarship.

## **Please Apply To Each Of The STOs List Below**

Each STO organization has their own application process which may require income verification. Some STOs require a single application for all 4 categories of scholarships and other STOs only require a single application for each of the 4 categories of scholarships. **As of July 1, 2023, you can only use one funding choice; either STO or ESA for the full school year. You cannot change your funding option until the following school year.**
